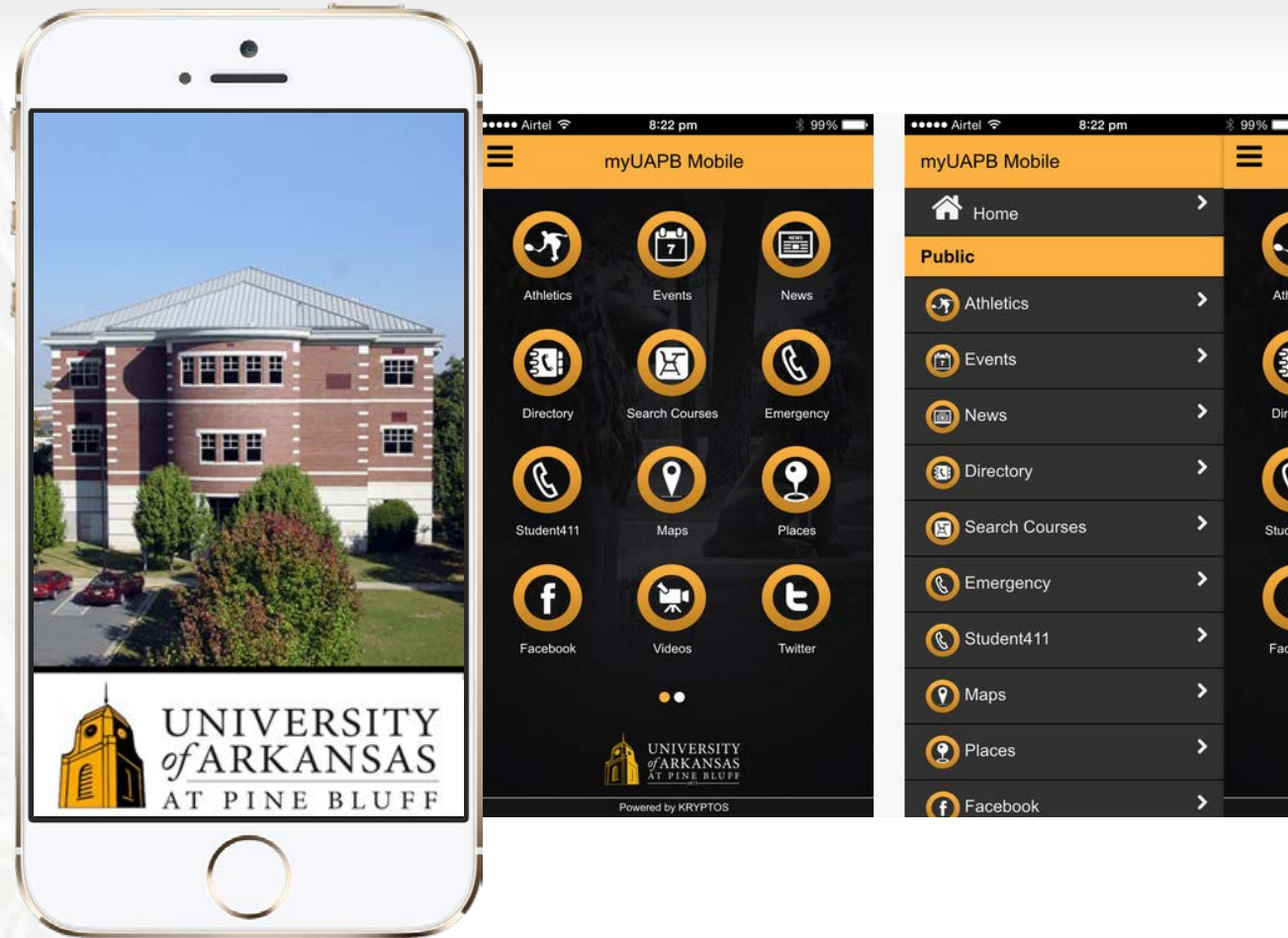

# FUNCTIONS

## Public Apps

Can be viewed by anyone who downloads the UAPB App

- **Athletics** – Check the latest news schedules and scores for all UAPB Sport Teams
- **Events** – Keep up with UAPB events
- **News** – Read the latest news about UAPB
- **Directory** – Find and send email to Faculty, Staff and Administrators instantly
- **Search Courses** – Search for and get a list of the course and its availability.
- **Emergency** – Contact local emergency numbers and dial with one touch from you finger
- **Student 411** – Most frequently asked questions and contact for most frequently sort out offices
- **Maps** – Search for buildings by name, pinpoint them on the map and see your relative location and explore by zooming and panning across a complete campus map
- **Places** – Locate the nearest and best local restaurant, recreational area, shopping mall and much more.

- **Facebook** – Keep in touch with your UAPB Facebook friends
- **Videos** – View UAPB videos
- **Twitter** – Twit your UAPB Friends
- **Admissions** – Apply on-line and get answers to your most frequent questions before you apply at the University.

**You are required to login to see information on the:**

- UAPB Email App
- Student App
- Faculty App
- Employee App

You must hold the role of an active student, faculty or staff member to access any of this information.

**For example:**

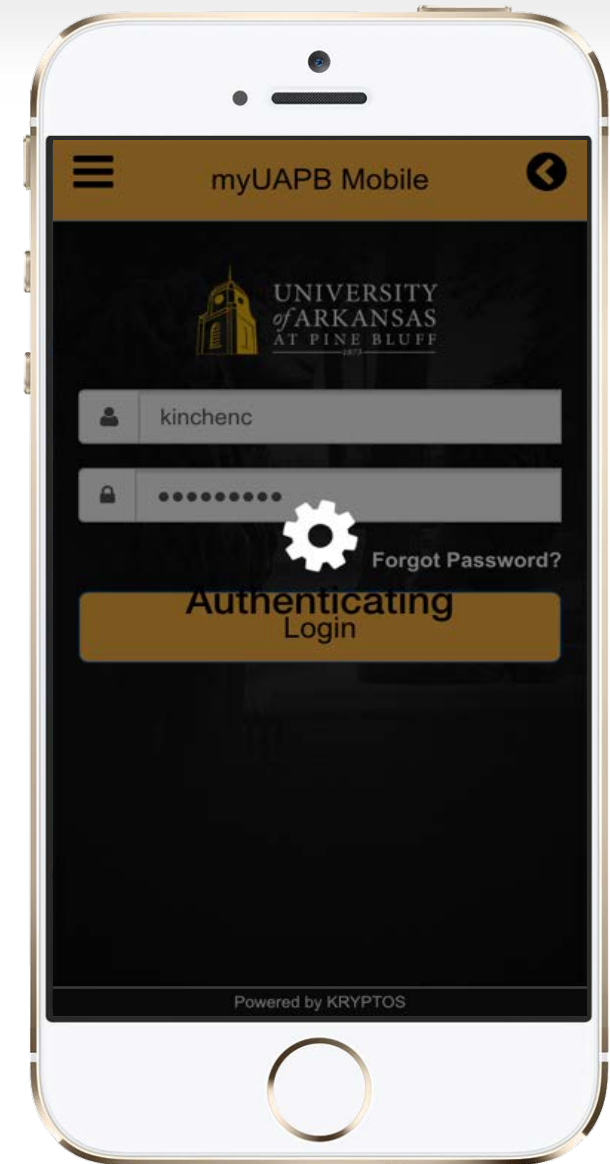
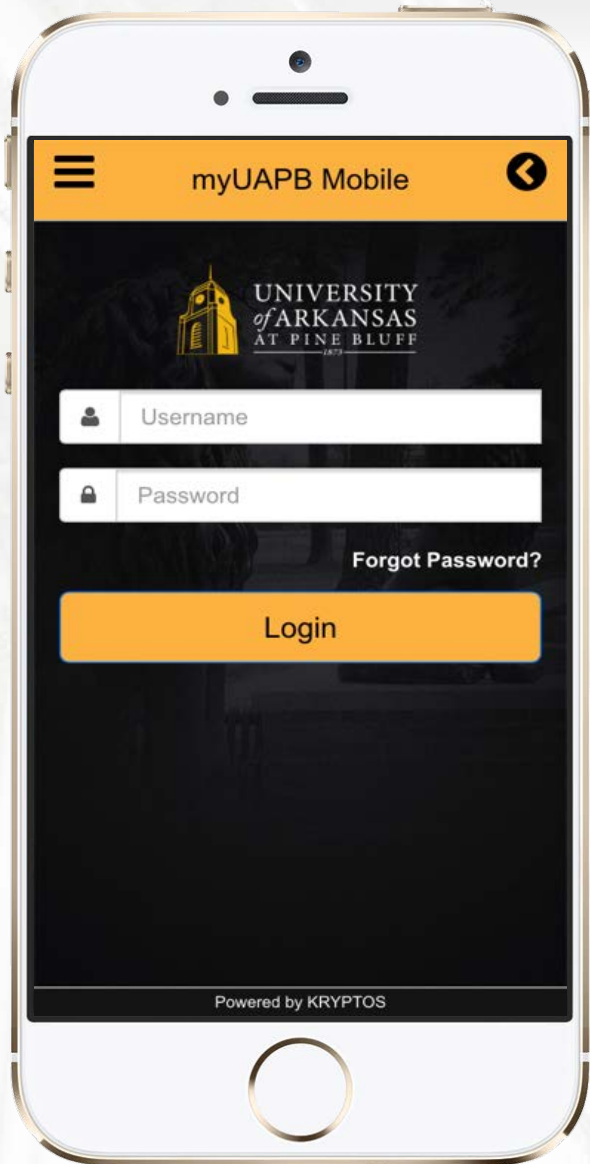
1. If you are a student you will see the Student App and the UAPB Email App.

## Designated Apps

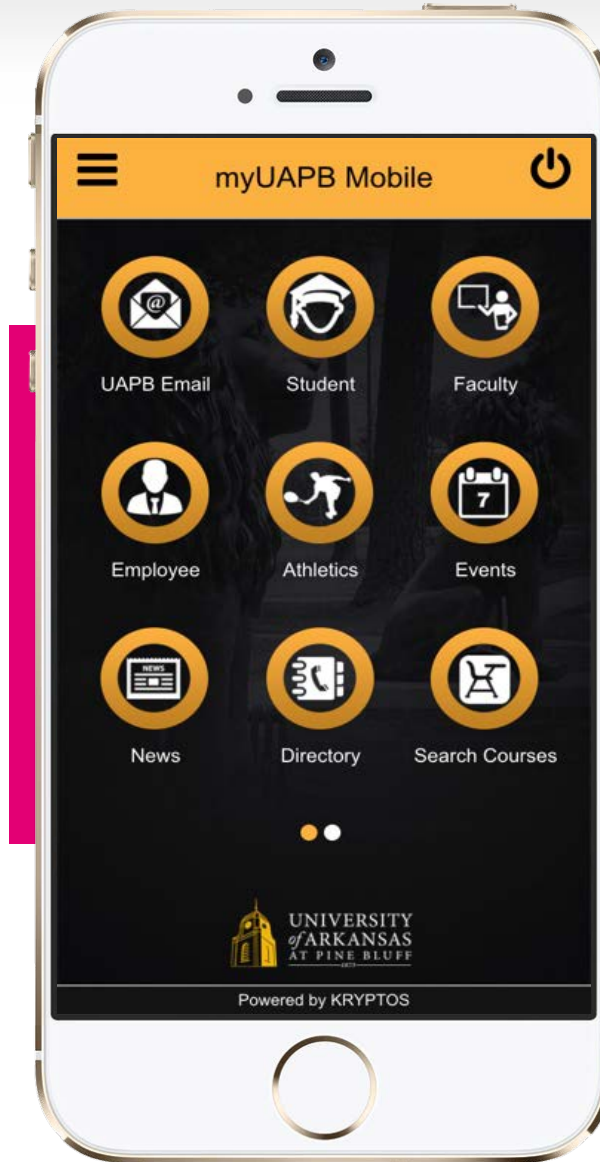
Can be viewed according to the role held on campus and these are private apps that can only be viewed when logged in.

Once logged in you will see the designated apps and public apps. You will also have access to the UAPB Email App

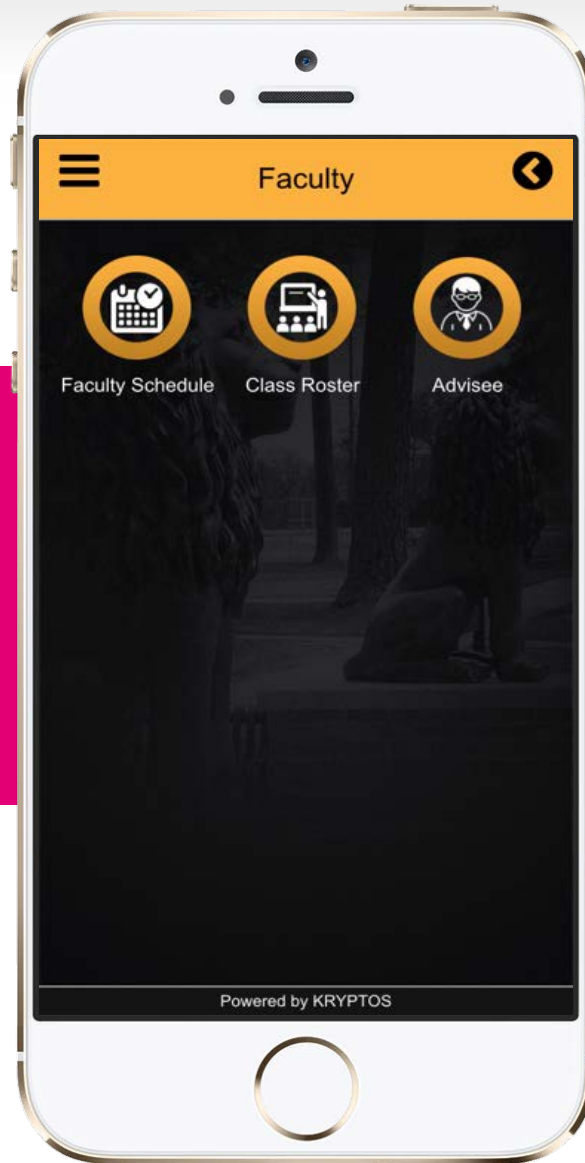

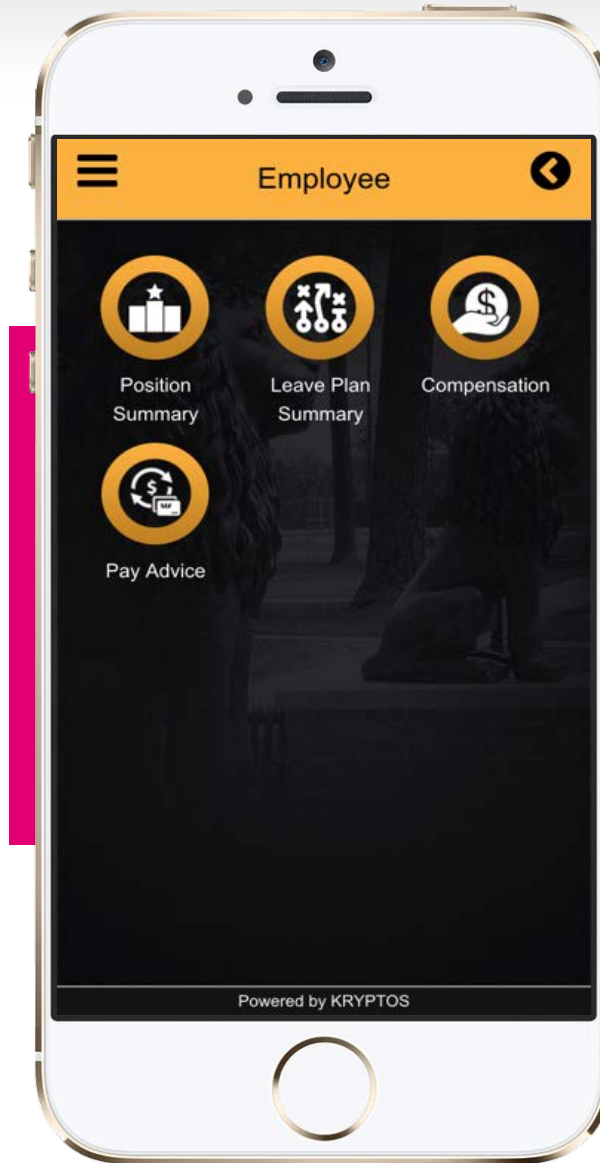
## Faculty Apps

## Designated Apps

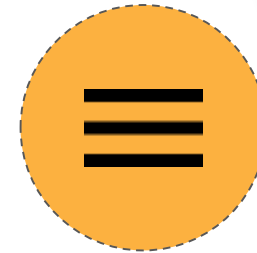
Can be viewed according to the role held on campus and these are private apps that can only be viewed when logged in.



## Employee Apps

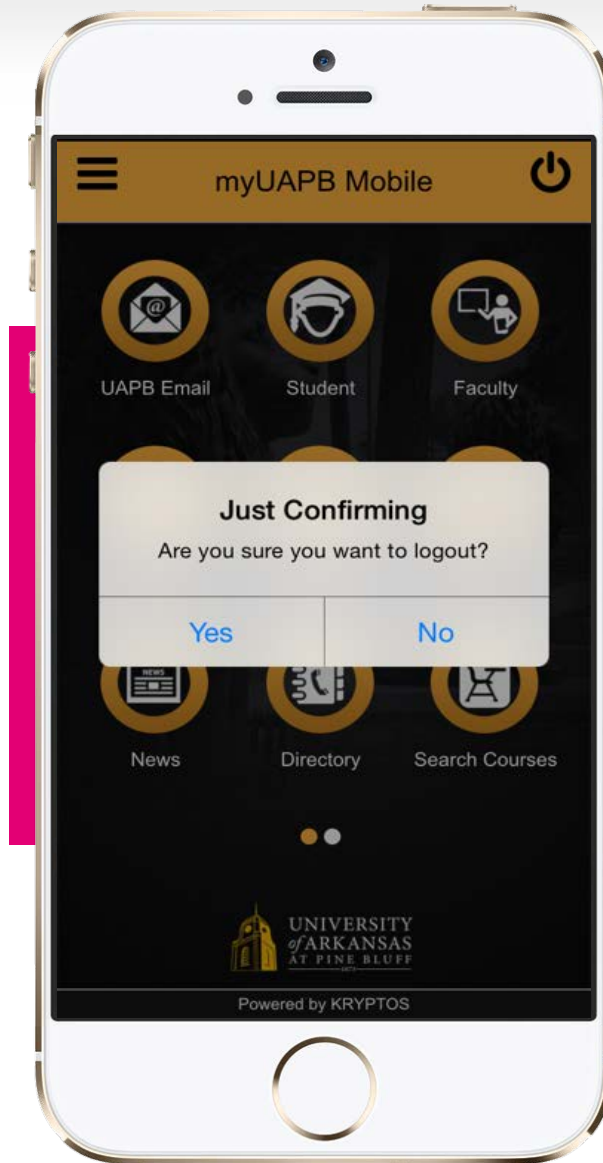
Login to view your position summary, leave plan summary, compensation and pay advice.
